

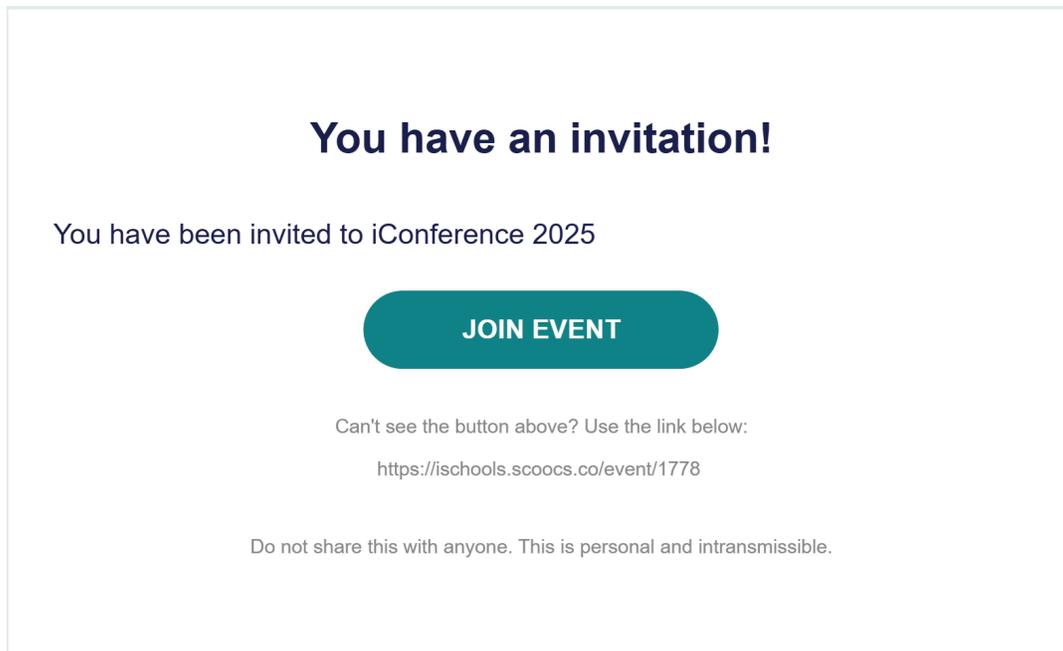
Dear iConference participant,

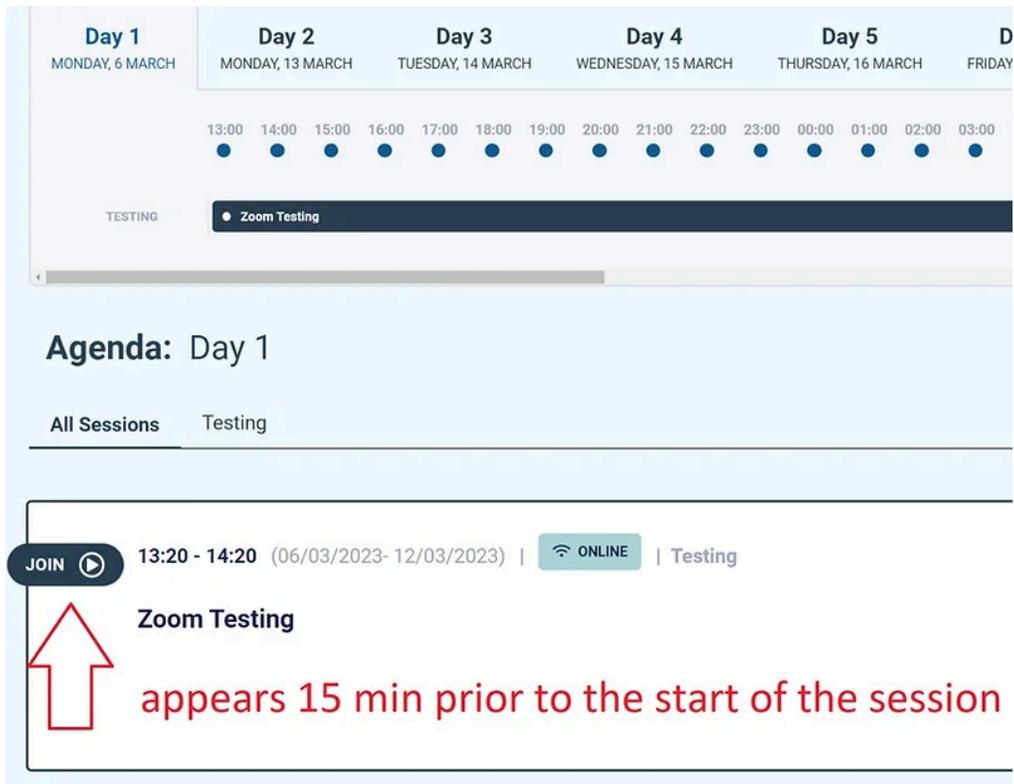

Joining a Session

For each session a **Join button** will appear **15 minutes** prior to the start of the session. After clicking the join button, you will be brought into the respective Zoom room automatically. We advise presenters to join early.

Closed sessions that are by invitation only, will not have a Join button. The session chairs provide the zoom link to invited participants only.

Tech Requirements

Zoom Client

Most sessions will use Zoom as the main conferencing software. Please check if your [Zoom client](#) is up to date.

We recommend the Google Chrome or the Firefox Browser

Please check if you have the latest version of [Google Chrome](#) browser [here](#) or the latest [Firefox](#) browser. Other browsers are also supported.

Internet Speed

Please guarantee that your internet speed is at least 3.2 Mbps outbound and 3.2 Mbps inbound. We also advise that your ping is below 300ms, [check here](#).

Conferencing

Set up your profile

To improve the social aspects of the conference, please upload a profile picture and provide some information about yourself. The information will be visible for other conference participants, but not to anyone outside the platform.

Explore

Once you are inside, we suggest you take a few minutes to explore and follow the wizard to learn about the conferencing platform.

Program Agenda

The session times in our Program Agenda have automatically adjusted to the local time on your device. Our global conference runs around the clock, which means some sessions can take place on different *dates* for differently located participants. This mostly impacts users who are relatively close to the international dateline (i.e. Eastern China, Western USA); those users should pay particular attention to session *dates* as well as times.

Personalize Your Program Schedule

The *My Program* feature allows you to make a custom schedule of sessions you want to attend. To get started, go to the Program Schedule and use the search bar to look-up your specific interests; then click the *star* icon corresponding to your favorites. These starred sessions will now show up under the *My Program* section, as your own customized event program.

Connect 1-to-1

Using *Chat*, you can skim through the participant list and reach out to fellow participants and speakers via this internal messaging feature.

Optional Matchmaking

Should you wish, you can set profile tags based on your interests. You will receive suggestions of potentially relevant connections from among conference attendees to whom you can reach out via the *Chat* feature.

Match Roulette

Not quite sure with whom to start a conversation? Try Match Roulette, which will put you in a chat room with another random participant who also wants to be matched. (Please note that if you find yourself alone in a room it might be because no one is currently accessing Match Roulette. Wait a few minutes or encourage others to join!)
