Grading system

Linnaeus University uses four different grading scales. The most common for international students is the A-F-scale where students are assessed with the criterion-based A-F grades (A, B, C, D, E, Fx or F). In order to pass the course, students need to meet the expected learning outcomes, which is stated in respective course syllabus. The grade A constitutes the highest grade on the scale and the remaining grades follow in descending order where the grade E is the lowest grade on the scale that will result in a pass. The grade F means that the student's performance is assessed as failed. Fx is not a grade and is only used when a student is allowed to complement the examination. For students who do not pass the examination, retake examinations are provided in accordance with local regulations at Linnaeus University. The other grading scales are: pass, pass with distinction, and fail; or pass and fail; or the grading scale for engineering students where 3-5 are passing grades.
